### Additional Information

Addison W. Hazard was the only child of Elisha Hazard and Diamdamia Jones. Addison Hazard married Sarah A. Jones in Canada. After his death, Sarah remarried to a Jenison, probably in California.

Addison Hazard was working as a clerk in Waterbury, Connecticut, when he enlisted on 13 August 1862 with Company I, 20<sup>th</sup> Connecticut Infantry Regiment as a Corporal. He mustered in 8 September 1862 at New Haven, Connecticut. On 1 November 1863 he deserted. He registered for the draft on 1 July 1863. On 20 July 1864 he was present at Peachtree Creek, Georgia.
