Daniel Marks enlisted under the name of Daniel Holbrook on 25 June 1863 and mustered in 1 July 1863 with Co L, 5th Cavalry Regiment Kansas. He transferred 20 July 1865 to Co B, 15th Cavalry Regiment Kansas and mustered out 19 October 1865. Some articles state that Holbrook was his mother's maiden name and others that it was the name of his foster parents.

Daniel Marks' son, Benjamin, was a Sergeant with the 187th Aero Squadron during World War I.
