Biographical Data on the Opp family from the History of John Opp and Lydia Ann Opp

John George's Father, Peter Opp, was reportedly from a wealthy family in Germany. The name used to be Count Von Oppen with an apparent castle. Peter Opp brought his entire family to America, just before the eldest son, John George was old enough to be drafted into the German army. The family had other Opp relatives in Pennsylvania. John George and his brother John enlisted in the Wisconsin Military around 1865. John, a prisoner of war, was released shortly after the war ended. The Opp brothers, John George and John must of have been close, both having married sisters, Lovina and Lydia Opp (their 2nd or 3rd cousins). Both families moved to Warrensburg, Johnson County, Missouri in 1871.
