Farmed in Wisconsin and then moved to Nemaha County, Kansas where he worked with his son-in-law J. E. Liebig in the hardware business. Came to California about 1905.

Jay's father, Christopher Powers, fought with Co D, 44th Wisconsin Infantry during the Civil War.
