Additional Information

Jacob Timken enlisted in Co B, Benton County Home Guard (AKA German Brigade) as a Private on 13 June 1861. The Home Guard was engaged at the Battle of Cole Camp beginning June 17th. The engagement was a result of rumors that Governor Jackson and other State Officials were trying to escape to Carthage, Missouri. Missouri Home Guard units were stationed east of Cole Camp to cut off the reported escape.

Jacob Timken enlisted in the 5th Regiment Provisional Enrolled Missouri Enrolled Militia on 1 June 1863 at Clinton Missouri. He Mustered In as a Private 1 June 1863 and Mustered Out 27 November 1863.

Henry Timken, son of Jacob, served as a Private in World War I with Co L, US 31st Infantry from 1 May 1918 to 19 January 1920

Jacob George Timken, son of Jacob, served as a Corporal in World War I with Co K, 363 Infantry from 26 April 1918 to 26 April 1919.
