James L. Wightman joined the 16th Kansas Cavalry Regiment in Monmouth on 25 February 1864 as a Private, and became a Commisary Sergeant on 1 March 1864, and later a First Lieutenant. He mustered out on 6 December 1865.

James L. Wightman was born in Dumfries, Scotland and was one of seven children of James Wightman and Mary Jane Brown. He went to Manchester, England before settling in New Jersey in 1840 as a farmer. In 1857 he moved to Kansas where he built an ore mill eventually moving to Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas. In 1870 he went to Colorado, and discovered gold, and was elected Recorder of the mines district in Conejos County, Colorado. He sold his Annie Mine in Colorado for \$60,000. He also built a wagon road from Silverton to Durango, Colorado. In 1880 he moved to Santa Ana, California.
