Jacob Willits arrived in Orange County in 1888 from Topeka, Kansas where he owned two valuable farms, one of 1240 acres and the other of 160 acres. When he came to Orange County he was reportedly worth \$100,000. He bought the H. H. Roper ranch of 120 acres located on Bristol Street. He worked at raising fast horses one of which was Silkwood. Willits trained the colt and often raced him not trusting another driver. Silkwood's record of 2:07 on the Santa Ana track was unsurpassed for a number of years.

Three of Jacob's grandsons saw service during World War I

- Coit F Willits enlisted in the Navy 19 January 1917
- Louis G Willits enlisted 10 January 1917 in the Navy as a Third Class Fireman serving on the US Cruiser San Diego
- Thomas H Willits enlisted in the aviation service and started training 19 February 1918 in San Diego.
