Additional Information

Harwood Sharp, age 18, a farmer born in England joined Co B, 26th Illinois US Infantry on 10 February 1864 at Freeport, Stephenson County, Illinois for a period of 3 years. He Mustered in 27 February 1864 at Springfield, Illinois and Mustered Out 20 July 1865 at Louisville, Davidson County, Kentucky. He was with his regiment during the Georgia campaign – from Atlanta to the sea.

Harwood Sharp lost his mother when he was about 6 years old and he lost his father 6 years later. Harwood immigrated to the United States in 1857 settling with his father and siblings, William and Elizabeth, in Illinois. His brother William and sister Elizabeth Taylor also took up residence in California.
